### Our Vision in the New Year

And he rolled up the scroll and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on him. A little over a year ago, the Session approved a new Vision Statement that would guide us until our 50th anniversary. It had three parts; *Rooted in Faith, Grounded in Love, and Moved to Serve*. Each part was based on scripture and while we did not say anything radically new, we did say something specific to our context. At the time the document was drafted, I had visions of how this statement would guide us and be used in our worship and life together. However, like most things, it slowly recessed back onto the shelf like a good book I've read and have fond memories of. Until I began to think about all the things that happened last year.

Briefly, in conversations and in meetings, I heard our Vision Statement mentioned or used as the basis for decisions. It was not grandiose but subtle as to how these three truths about scripture, love, and service have begun to sprout saplings in the ground. To give you one example, our Mission and Benevolence Committee rewrote their purpose statement around Moved to Serve and found focus and clarity about what kinds of missions we want to support and partner with.

In surprising ways, I find that this Vision Statement is coming alive. However, the impetus for this is God's Spirit at work. There is another conviction we hold on to that when God's word is spoken, it does not come back void. Our Vision Statement does not equal Scripture in any way, but the foundation of our statement is built on Scripture and that has stood the test of time.

As we enter the new year, it's time to dust off our Vision Statement and reflect on it for a new year. What is God saying to us now, how have we grown since we drafted those words, and how does God want to fulfill them? In January, we will dive back into the Scripture verses that grounded our Vision Statement and pray that God would fulfill His Word toward us. That we may experience a new greater faith, deeper love, and vibrant ministry for the glory of God.
