


CHILDREN & YOUTH


JOY Class: is exploring a unique and different approach in the study of Bible Scripture called *The Serendipity Bible*.



This year's Horizon's Bible study book *Let Justice Roll Down: God's Call to Care for Neighbors and All Creation* by Patricia K. Tull; with Suggestions for Leaders by Rebecca Barnes

According to Scripture, the earth and its members belong to God. We are called to care for creation not only because God loves it, but also because a healthy creation supports human well-being. This PW Horizons Bible study is an invitation to explore and to act, with all our hearts, in responding to an issue that impacts all life on God's earth. Readers will learn about ecological systems, the challenges we face in this time of accelerated climate change, and the



possibilities available to address or counter the impact of human-made stress on our environment.



Do you remember from the Bible stories about gleaning a field? Something was left in the field so that those in need could come and pick what was remaining for their own use. *The Society of St. Andrew (SoSA)* gleans fields after the harvest and donates that food to organizations that feed the hungry. This month they are celebrating the one BILLIONTH pound of food that they have harvested. That means that one billion pounds of food was not allowed to waste away in the field and that one billion pounds of food was used to feed hungry people. WOW!

SoSA needs volunteers to help gather all that food. Now that the weather is cooling is a good time to spend a few hours in the field harvesting food. This is a good out of doors activity for individuals, families, or groups such as Sunday School classes and you don't have to pull out your wallet or write a check to help feed someone.
