

Martha Newhart, Kim Freeman, Melonie Hall, Dara Burgess, Eric Saegebarth, and Ken Lasseter will be visiting our partner church in Remedios, Cuba February 18 through 25. With your help we will carry with us over-

the-counter medications, as in previous visits. These common medications are very scarce and expensive in Cuba, when they can be found. There will be a collection box in Reception Hall. Please, no gummies. Some Sunday School supplies (crayons, glue sticks etc.) are also very much desired.

Thanks to you, Ken made a shipment of food to the Church in Remedios in December and will make another one in January. Ken was told on my trip in December that many people only get one meal a day. The Remedios church serves about 40 people lunch 3 times a week and breakfast 2 times a week. They are getting some help from the Bread for the World organization.

Attendance is up in many churches in Cuba. They know that some people are coming for the food, but they also know that many people are coming to church seeking HOPE.


Nursery is available from **9:00 – 11:00am** every Sunday morning for children **birth to 4 years old.**

- The Rabbi (God's Word): Go beyond a Sunday-school approach to the Bible by digging into the original languages and deeper meanings of the Holy Scriptures.




BIBLE STUDY WITH PASTOR OSCAR


